**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO
CONSOLIDATE AND TO APPOINT
INTERIM CLASS COUNSEL**

Pending before the Court is Plaintiffs' motion to consolidate and appoint interim class counsel. Having considered the papers submitted and the oral argument of counsel, the Court hereby **GRANTS** the motion.

2. Every pleading filed in these consolidated actions, or in any separate action included herein, shall bear the following caption:

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on attorneys from their firms to litigate the case. The Court encourages the active participation of (and Court appearances by) attorneys with fewer than 5 years of experience where appropriate.

2. Interim Class Counsel shall have sole authority to communicate with Defendants' counsel, any third-parties, and the Court on behalf of all plaintiffs in the putative Class. Defendants' counsel may rely on all agreements made with Interim Class Counsel and such agreements shall be binding on all counsel for the Class.

3. Interim Class Counsel shall submit a proposed protocol for controlling attorneys' fees and expenses within one week of the date of this order. *See, e.g., In re Carrier IQ Consumer Privacy Litig.*, No. 12-md-02330-EMC (Docket No. 100); *In re Chrysler-Dodge-Jeep Ecodiesel Mktg., Sales Pracs. & Prods. Liab. Litig.*, No. 17-md-2777 EMC (N.D. Cal.) (Docket No. 181); *In re Fibrogen, Inc. Secs. Litig.*, No. C-21-2623 EMC (N.D. Cal.) (Docket No. 94).
